

## 2020 Graduating High School Senior Scholarship

**Purpose:** The Trabuco Hills High PTSA offers 4 Graduating Senior scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to acknowledge the achievements of high school seniors in their school, on the THHS PTSA and in the community.

**Availability**: Scholarship funds are available to high school seniors who are currently PTSA members at Trabuco Hills High School and graduating between January 1 and June 23 of the current academic year. This scholarship needs to be used during the fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited college or university, community college or trade/technical school.

**Application and due date:** An application may be obtained from Autumn McClenaghan in the THHS Guidance Office. References are to be completed by an adult who can speak on behalf of your qualifications. The completed reference form and letter should be given to the applicant in a sealed envelope to be included with the application packet. Do not submit more than one reference form or letter.

Completed application, essay responses and reference form(s) and letter(s) in sealed envelopes are to be submitted to Autumn McClenaghan in the THHS Guidance Office and received by **April 24th no later than 3 PM**. Application will not be considered if received after the due date or if any of the required materials are missing. Original application and reference forms with letter(s) must be delivered in person.

Facsimiles will not be accepted.

### **Qualifications**

This scholarship recognizes an outstanding student in the school, PTSA and community who has a minimum grade point average requirement of 2.0 or better. Consideration will be given to students for the following:

- Academic Achievement
- Community Service
- Leadership
- PTSA Involvement
- School Participation
- Financial Need

PTSA membership is also required.

### Selection

Recipients are selected by representatives of the Trabuco Hills High Senior Scholarship Committee and approved by the PTSA association meetings. A check for the scholarship will be given directly to the recipient at the Senior Award Night ceremony.
